



## The Lainie Jones Comprehensive Cancer Survivorship Act Social Media Toolkit

### About the CCSA:

The Lainie Jones Comprehensive Cancer Survivorship Act is bipartisan legislation reintroduced in 2026 by Representatives Debbie Wasserman Schultz, Brian Fitzpatrick, Mark DeSaulnier, and Joe Wilson. The bill addresses the entire continuum of cancer care, from diagnosis through post-treatment and beyond, to improve survivorship, care coordination, and quality of life for the 18 million Americans living with, through, and beyond cancer.

Key provisions include Medicare coverage of survivorship care planning and care coordination services, an alternative payment model for quality survivorship care, a cancer survivor employment assistance program, improved Medicaid coverage for childhood and adolescent cancer survivors, expanded access to fertility services for survivors, and continued support for the Office of Cancer Survivorship.
