Definitions

Survivor

NCCS' definition of a survivor is from the time of diagnosis through the balance of life. NCCS expanded its definition to include family, friends, and caregivers.

Health Equity

(NCI, n.d.)

A situation in which all people are given the chance to live as healthy a life as possible regardless of their race, ethnicity, sex, gender identity, sexual orientation, disability, education, job, religion, language, where they live, or other factors.

A lack of health equity can result in differences in health outcomes, such as rates and severity of disease, disability, death, and quality of life.
